Keeping Children Safe Online

The virtual world of gaming and phone apps can offer our children a lot of creativity and downtime. However, it can also leave our children vulnerable to cyber bullying and cybercrime. Having a digital family agreement is one way in which parents can strike up conversations with their children and agree online boundaries, such as time, and discuss the importance of being safe online. This sets clear rules for the child and when broken, they will understand that there can be consequences.

Nursery Spaces

The term after your child turns 3 years old, your child is entitled to up to 30 hours a week free early education and this free funding can be used to access a place in our Nursery Class. We are also placing children's names on our waiting list for September 2022, so please do contact the school office if you are interested in a nursery place for your child.
