### **Covid-19**

We are pleased to report that the number of positive cases of Covid-19 has started to reduce considerably and are currently isolated to individual cases, rather than the outbreak we have experienced in the past weeks. From Monday, the children will no longer be working in bubbles. However, clubs will still remain as working parents clubs until the end of term.

A reminder about the guidelines after testing positive – if a negative test is completed on days 5 and 6, children and staff are able to return to school. If still testing positive on day 10, they are no longer classed as being infectious, so can return to school.

Parents and carers are no longer expected to wear face coverings during pick up and drop offs. However, we request politely that they continue to be worn if you access the inside of any of our school site.

Information has gone on our app and emailed to parents last week. Please book your appointment on Wisepay. Closing date to book is today. Masks must be worn when attending. The carpark will be open from 3.15 but please do not try to come in before this time as we need to ensure children and parents are safely out of the playground.
