



Curriculum overview in Y6 for Spring Term 2

Religious education

This half term, our topic is 'Jesus the Messiah'. We will be focusing on Easter and Holy Week, looking at the events that led up to the Crucifixion and the Resurrection.

This half term, we will begin by studying 'The Viewer'. We will be writing our own Dystopian stories based on images used in the book. We will then be creating an explanation text and writing about a machine that can show the future. After this, we will be writing a persuasive letter based on our Geography topic of South America.

English

Topic- Geography

Our topic in Geography for this half term is South America. We will be looking at maps of countries, landscape and climate. We will spend time focusing on human and physical geography of South America. We will then look at Brazil and compare the affluent areas with areas of poverty, looking specifically at Shanty Towns.

PSHE

Our topic is 'Families and Relationships'. We will be discussing different types of relationships and what it means to have a healthy relationship. We will discuss and debate topics in order to gain a deeper understanding of society.

Computing

In computing, we will be learning about spreadsheets and using spreadsheets in order to display data.

This half term, our topics are: Algebra; Area, Perimeter and Volume; Geometry; Position and Movement and Graphs and Averages. We will have finished teaching the Year 6 Maths curriculum by the end of the half term. This will give us time to revise and recap areas of weakness before SATs in May. We will be completing weekly arithmetic tests to improve the children's fluency in the four operations and fractions, decimals and percentages.

PE

This half term, we are learning Tag Rugby and Badminton. In Tag Rugby, we will be looking at defending skills and dodging skills. We will be working on communication skills and developing the skills of a good 'sportsperson'.



Maths

'Set Sail for Success'

Topic-Science

We will be continuing to study Forces. We will be completing Science experiments encouraging the children to become more independent. We will be writing up Science experiments and thinking deeper about the world around us.

DT

We will be finishing off our slippers in Textiles for the first part of the half term. Then, we're going to be focusing on Food Technology. We will be looking at South American foods and having a go at creating some of our own foods.

French

This half term, we're looking at retrieving our previous French knowledge as well as looking at the units of Rigolo about activities that we enjoy doing. We are developing our skills of being able to record our knowledge in writing.
