Year 4 - Time and Tide Museum and Lydia Eva Outing - Monday 20th June 2022

We are pleased to inform you that we have booked an outing for Year 4 on Monday 20th June. We will be visiting the Time and Tide Museum, Great Yarmouth in the morning to take part in a history workshop called 'Fish Ahoy!' As part of the visit, children will have the opportunity to handle artefacts, try on costumes and take part in role play activities to investigate the lives of fisherman and gutting girls. In the afternoon we will be taking the opportunity to visit the nearby Lydia Eva boat, docked at South Quay and the last surviving steam herring drifter. The trip will link in with our History lessons for this half term of the fishing industry around Great Yarmouth and we anticipate it will really allow the topic to be brought to life.

Children will need to wear their school uniform for the trip, including a raincoat and will need to bring a small bag containing their packed lunch. As this trip is on a Monday there is not an option for a school packed lunch. Please ensure your child has a packed lunch from home.

We will be departing at 9:15 so children will need to arrive at school at normal time and should arrive back by 3.00pm.

We are asking for a voluntary donation of £12.50 for this visit for the cost of your child's visit. This visit will be subsidised by the school.
