Parking in front of the school gates

There have been an increasing number of vehicles parking in front of the school gates at lunchtime and at the end of the day. These gates MUST remain clear to provide access on and off the site at all times for emergency vehicles and contractors.

Morning Drop Off

With the continuing bad weather, we have more cars than usual dropping off in the car park in the morning. If you need to drop your child off, please come fully into the car park where Mr Lawrence, the caretaker, is on duty. Do not pull over in the entrance way as this makes access difficult for other vehicles and poses a danger to pedestrians. Once in the car park, please wait patiently in the queue and do not attempt to overtake other vehicles, as children may be exiting from both sides of the vehicle. Cones have been put out to stop this happening, but some drivers are ignoring these and cutting past other cars.

Coats

Due to the continued inclement weather, please ensure that your child has a coat. We have had several children turn up for school when it is cold and raining in just fleeces and jumpers.
