Bakery	A shop which sells bread and cakes
Fire hook	A hook used to pull down the houses to slow the spread of the fire
Leather bucket	Buckets were made of leather
River Thames	The river which runs through London
Diary	A book used to write about your day
King Charles II	The name of the king at the time of the fire
Samuel Pepys	Wrote a diary about the fire
Thomas Farriner	The owner of the bakery where the fire started
