In Reception children will learn the following:

Seasons-Autumn

By the end of this topic, we want the children to have an embedded knowledge of the following:

- In Autumn we see the autumnal colours red, brown, yellow, orange and green.
- Due to the change in weather, leaves begin to fall off the trees in preparation for Winter.
- Autumn is one of the four seasons that occur over the year.
- Animals begin to find food outside in preparation for Winter (hibernation).





Key vocabulary your child will learn and can define are:	
Autumn	A season that comes after Summer, preparing us for Winter.
Hibernation	The períod when an animal stays dormant (asleep) during the cold Winter months.
Weather	The change of state in the atmosphere. For example: Rain, cloud, thunder, sunshine etc.
Temperature	Temperature is used to describe how cold or hot something is including the weather or food.
