

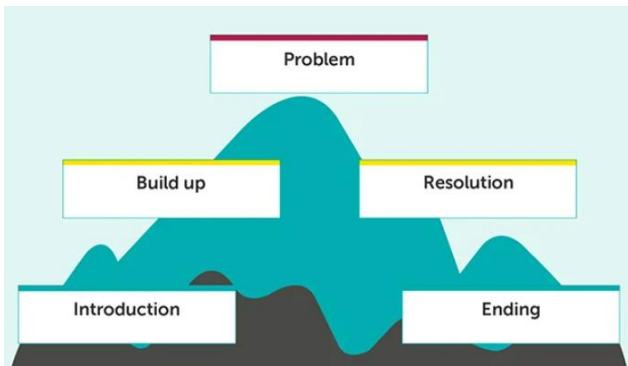
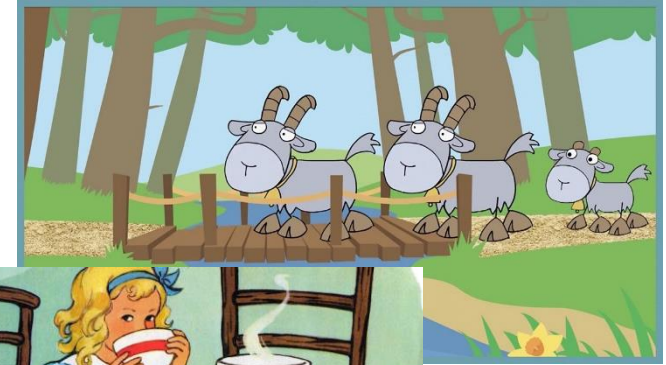
Fairy Tale Knowledge Organiser- Reception

Fairy Tales

By the end of this topic, we want the children to have an embedded knowledge of the following:

- Fiction texts refer to books and stories about imaginary people.
- Fiction stories have characters and settings.
- Stories have a beginning, build up, problem, resolution and ending.
- Traditional tales have been told for many years and can have alternative endings.



Key vocabulary your child will learn and can define are:

Fiction	Fiction texts are imaginary (made up stories).
Character	A person or narrated animal in a story.
Setting	The place an event takes place.
Traditional Tale	Stories that are well known and have been told for many years.
Intruded	When a person goes into a place uninvited.
