Medicine must contain information including the child's name and class, amount prescribed and the time it needs to be taken.</p> <p>Absence Reminder</p> <p>If your child is unwell or unable to attend school, please ensure the office is contacted by 8:30am. Alternatively you can leave a voice mail or email the office on office@smspprimary.norfolk.sch.uk.</p> <p>Water bottles</p> <p>We are hoping that the weather is going to continue improving and therefore we will be encouraging the children to drink lots of water.
