In **Reception** children will learn the following:

Seasons- Spring

By the end of this topic, we want the children to have an embedded knowledge of the following:

- The weather brightens and the temperature begins to increase.
- There are more hours of daylight, increasing each day.
- Plants, flowers and trees resume growth.
- Animals that hibernate during Winter begin to wake up.
- Baby animals are born including rabbits, chicks, lambs and calves.



Key vocabulary your child will learn and can define are:

Spring	The brighter season that begins after Winter ends.
Weather	The change of state in the atmosphere. For example: rain, cloud, thunder, sunshine etc.
Temperature	Temperature is used to describe how cold or hot something is including the weather or food.
Blossomed	The appearance of flowers on plants and trees. <i>E.g., The trees have blossomed in pink flowers.</i>
Offspring	A baby animal in relation to their mother.
