

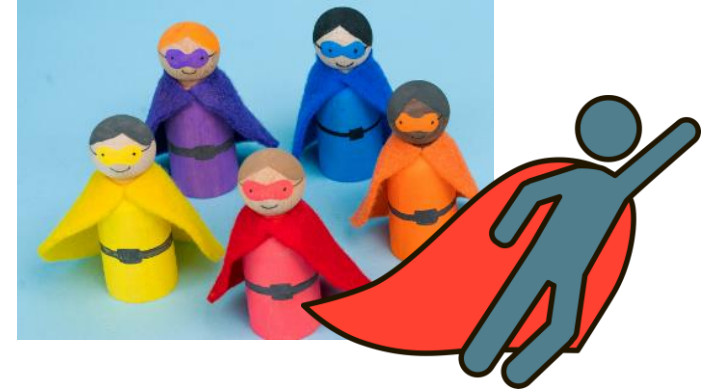
## Superheroes Knowledge Organiser- Reception

In **Reception** children will learn the following:

### **Superheroes/People Who Help Us- Fictional and Real Life**

By the end of this topic, we want the children to have an embedded knowledge of the following:

- Superheroes in stories and films are fictional.
- Hero's (both fictional and real) help protect people in the community.
- Police, Fire Fighters, Doctors, Nurses, RNLI and dentists provide a service to help us.
- The following services are available when calling **999** in an emergency: Police, Fire Engine, RNLI or an Ambulance.



Key vocabulary your child will learn and can define are:

<b>Superhero</b>	A made-up character in a fiction text.
<b>Hero</b>	A person who is admired for their courage.
<b>Villain</b>	A character who demonstrates evil behaviours.
<b>Rescue</b>	When someone is saved from a dangerous or difficult situation.
<b>Protect</b>	To keep someone safe from harm or injury.
