By the end of this topic, we want the children to have an embedded knowledge of the following:

- Know that we are all unique and have our own similarities and differences.
- Know that families are made up of different people and can children will be able to talk about members of their immediate family and community.
- Know that we are born as babies and grow up to be children, then adults.
- Know that our faces are made up of features including eyes, eyebrows, eyelashes, nose, lips, ears and freckles.



By the end of this topic, the children will know the following information about their local area:

- Know that we live on **Earth** in the **Country, England**, in the **Town, Great Yarmouth**.
- Know that we live in homes including houses, bungalows, flats, and caravans.
- Know that maps tell us how to get to a new destination.
- Know that they pass familiar places on their journey to school including a park, post-box, shop etc.
- Know that they belong to their school community at St Mary and St Peter's Catholic Primary School.

Key vocabulary your child will learn and can define are:
