Historical Events Knowledge Organiser-Nursery

In Nursery children will learn the following:

Bonfire Night (Guy Fawkes) and Remembrance Day







By the end of this topic, we want the children to have an embedded knowledge of the following:

- That On 5th November we celebrate Bonfire Night/Guy Fawkes.
- To know that Guy Fakes lived in the **past** and that bonfires and fireworks are still let off in the **present**.
- Bonfires and fireworks are set off each year to remember that Guy Fawkes failed, in his plot to blow up King James 1.

Key vocabulary your child will learn and can define are:	
Past	Having existed or taken place in a period before the present.
Present	Exísting or occurring now.



By the end of this topic, we want the children to have an embedded knowledge of the following:

- In the **past** there was a war and soldiers died trying to keep us safe.
- In the **present** red poppies are worn as a symbol of respect to remember Soldier's who died in the war.

Key vocabulary your child will learn and can define are:	
Past	Having existed or taken place in a period before the present.
Present	Exísting or occurring now.
Remembrance	A memory of an event that took place in the past.
Poppies	A red flower that is worn during Remembrance to acknowledge the soldiers that fought bravely.
