



Curriculum overview in Y5 for Spring Term 1

Religious Education

This half term in RE we are learning about God's covenants We will be identifying the differences between contracts and covenants and some covenants God has had with others.

PSHE

In PHSE we will be exploring how to manage and respond to feelings appropriately and proportionately in different situations. We will discuss the importance of self-respect and how to manage set backs.

We are continuing to develop our speaking, listening, reading and writing skills. We are learning how to

This half term we will be focusing on Dodgeball and Netball. In Dodgeball we will be practicing our skills of throwing, catching and dodging before applying these skills to a game situation. In Netball we will be learning to use a range of different passes to keep possession and attack towards a goal.

English

In English, our key text for this term is 'Wonder' by DC Palencio. We will use this story as inspiration for our own writing to create stories that raise issues. We will also spend some time on narrative poetry and will be reading The Highwayman by Albert Nowes. We will be continuing to more complex sentence construction, focusing on relative clauses and commas to clarify meaning.



<u>Maths</u>

<u>Multiplication and division</u> - We will be focusing on using formal written methods to multiply and divide increasingly large numbers. We will apply this learning by solving real life problems.

<u>Fractions</u> - We will develop on their prior learning, moving onto multiplying fractions and calculations fractions of amounts.

Geography

In Geography, we are learning about North
America. We will be finding out about the 23
countries that make up this diverse continent. In
our lessons we will explore the different climate
zones and we will research the human and
physical features of North America. We will
then look more closely at California and the San
Andreas fault.
